SPECIAL HEALTH APPRAISAL

If, in the opinion of a school principal or other administrator, an employee's health becomes such that it may adversely affect the health or safety of others; that he is unable to render satisfactory service in his position; or that the educational opportunities of children are impaired or endangered by him, the employee's condition will be reported to the superintendent of schools or the superintendent's representative. The superintendent of schools or the representative shall prepare a recommendation consistent with the medical findings and judgment and present it to the Board of Education for such action as it may deem appropriate.
