

EXCEPTIONS TO DISTRICT GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Notwithstanding the provisions of Policy 6150, a high school diploma shall be issued to any student who:

1. has been a child in the custody of the Secretary of Social and Rehabilitation Services or the **Commissioner of Juvenile Justice at any time on or after the student's fourteenth birthday;**
2. is at least seventeen (17 years of age);
3. **is enrolled in a Topeka Public Schools' high school; and**
4. has achieved at least the minimum high school graduation requirements adopted by the state board of education.
